

# Frequently Asked Questions

## Executive Master of Science in Management of Technology - Georgia Tech

### What is the difference between this program and a traditional MBA?

The Executive Master's Program in Management of Technology is an MBA "plus." It includes a traditional MBA curriculum, as well as topics of importance to technology-driven organizations.

### What is the red-carpet treatment?

Going back to school can be stressful. We strive to make sure that your experience at Georgia Tech is hassle-free. We take care of all the details and walk you through the process step-by-step.

### Are there specific program concentrations?

Because the program itself covers an array of topics we do not offer specific concentrations.

### What is the program format?

Classes meet every other weekend, all day Friday and Saturday. The program also includes two week-long residencies (Monday-Friday) in Atlanta, and an international study tour.

### Is the program offered on-line?

No. Much of the program coursework requires you to work in groups with your classmates.

### What will my diploma say?

Georgia Institute of Technology, Master of Science in Management of Technology

### When does the program begin?

The Class of 2007 begins on May 8, 2006. A new class enrolls in early spring of each year.

### How long is the program?

19 months

### What is the average size of each class?

The program generally enrolls between 40-50 students each spring.

### Where are classes held?

Classes will be held in the new state-of-the-art Huang Executive Education Center, located at the corner of West Peachtree Street and 5th Street in Georgia Tech's new campus addition, Technology Square.

### Will I have access to Georgia Tech resources?

Yes, you will have access to all student resources including study areas, computer labs, and the new Campus Recreation Center.

### Will I need a laptop computer?

Yes. Specific parameters are available at <http://execmot.org>.



### How much time outside of class will I need?

Most students spend approximately 15-20 hours per week studying and in group meetings.

### How much does the program cost?

The cost of the program for the class entering in May of 2006 is \$59,000.

### Is there financial aid available?

### Is corporate sponsorship required for admission?

Financial sponsorship is not required, but your employer must support your attendance.

### What if I am from out-of-town?

Travel expenses and accommodations are not included in the cost of the program, but we will gladly give you a list of local lodging.

### What are the admission requirements?

- A bachelor's degree (in any field) from an accredited university
- At least five years of professional experience
- Two professional recommendations
- A personal interview
- GMAT may be required pending academic profile

### How do I apply?

### When is the application deadline?

April 14, 2006. Applications received after this date will be accepted on a space available basis.

### When will I know if I have been accepted?

The admissions process takes two to four weeks after we have received your completed application.
