Industrial Design Senior Wins InVenture Prize Daniel Chaney takes home \$15,000 and patent help for "Slide Capo" guitar accessory.






Outreach: Competition a Breeding Ground for Genuinely New Musical Instruments


Peponis, Gamble Appointed Associate Chairs in School of Architecture
