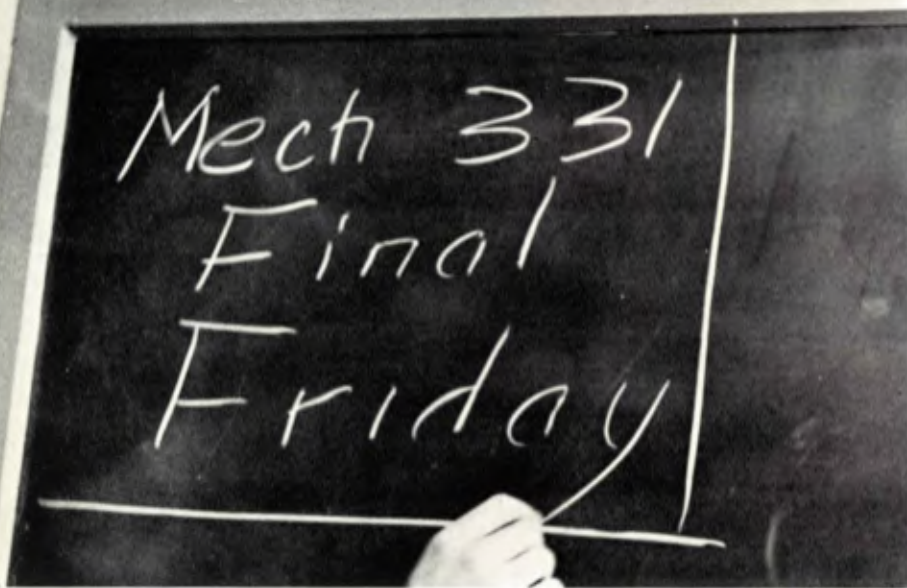




CLASSES

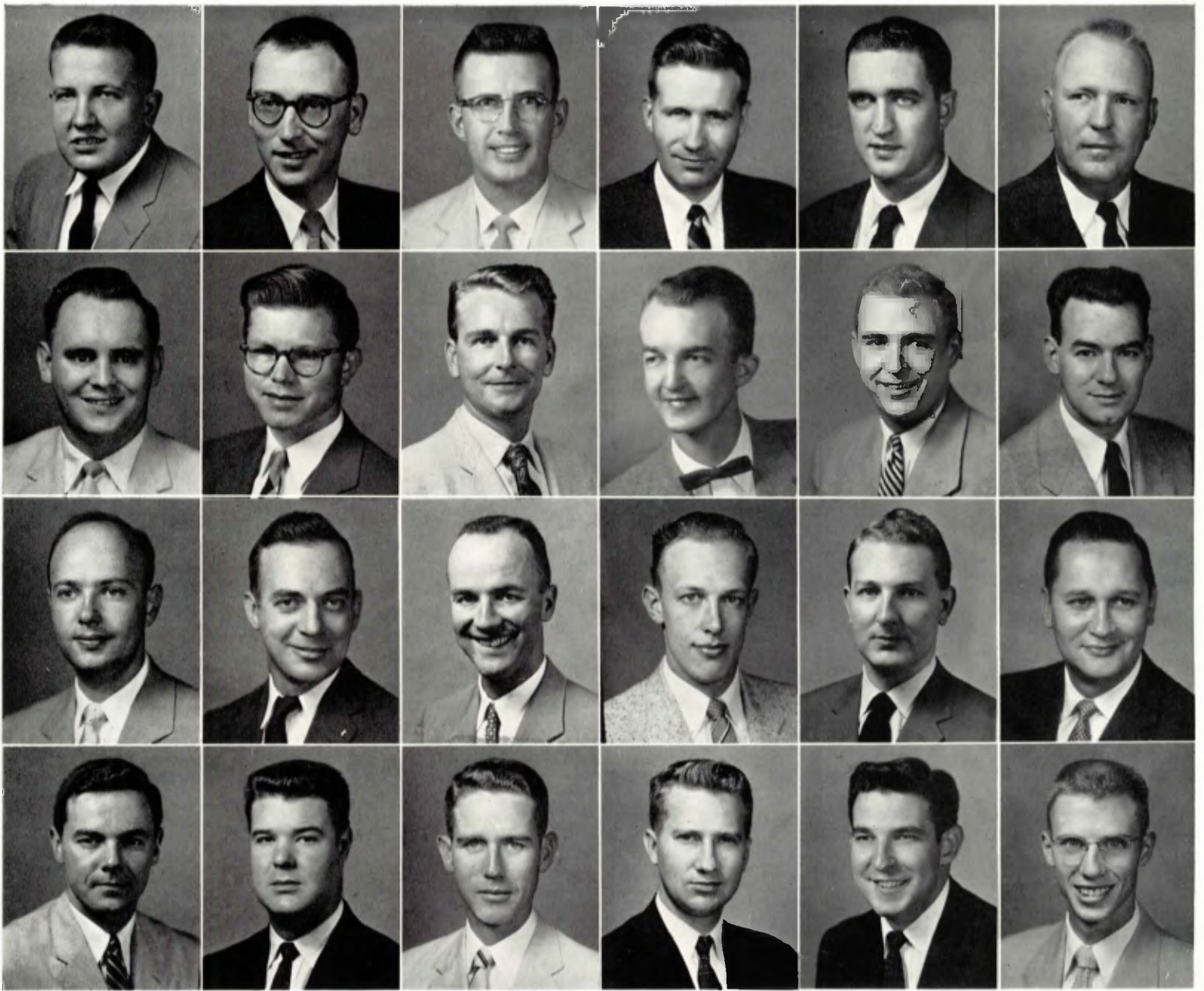

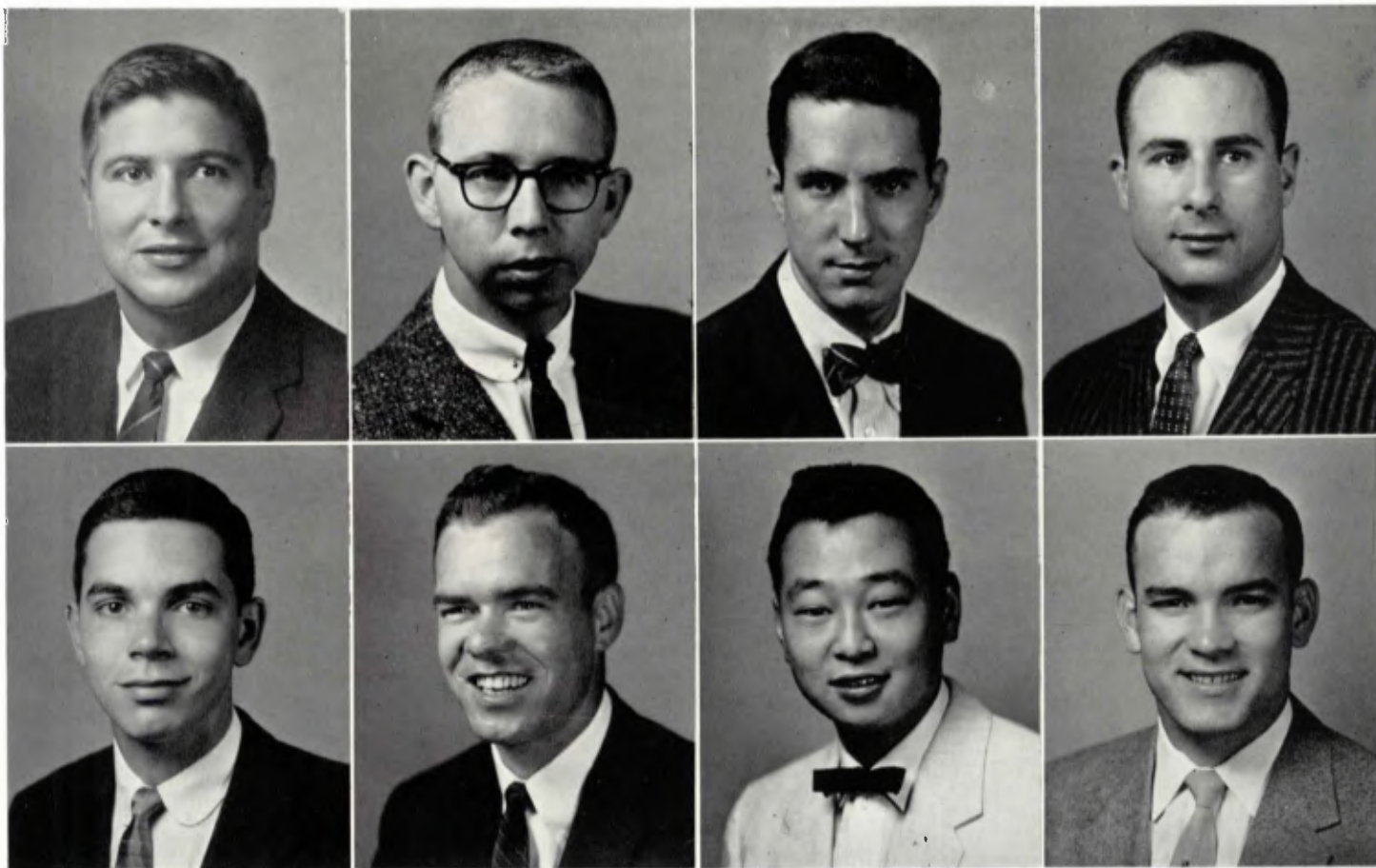

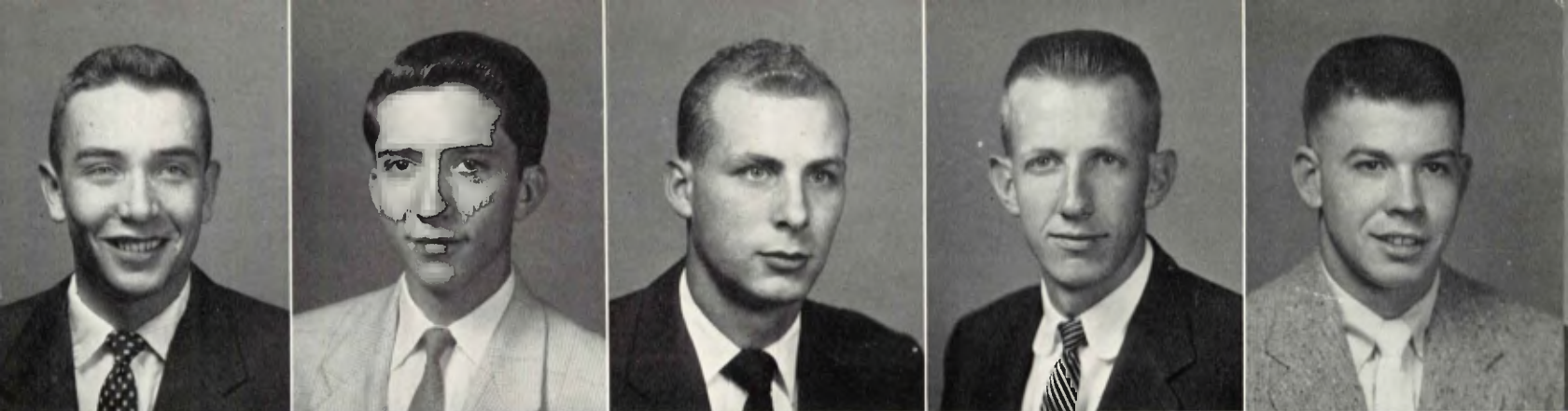
SENIOR CLASS
