

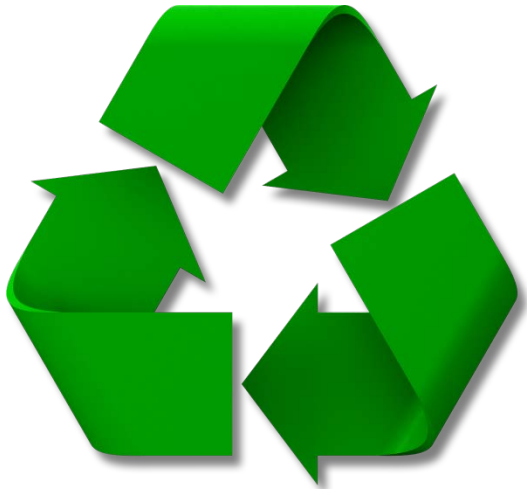


Uniqueness of the GKR

Translating Geek Speak

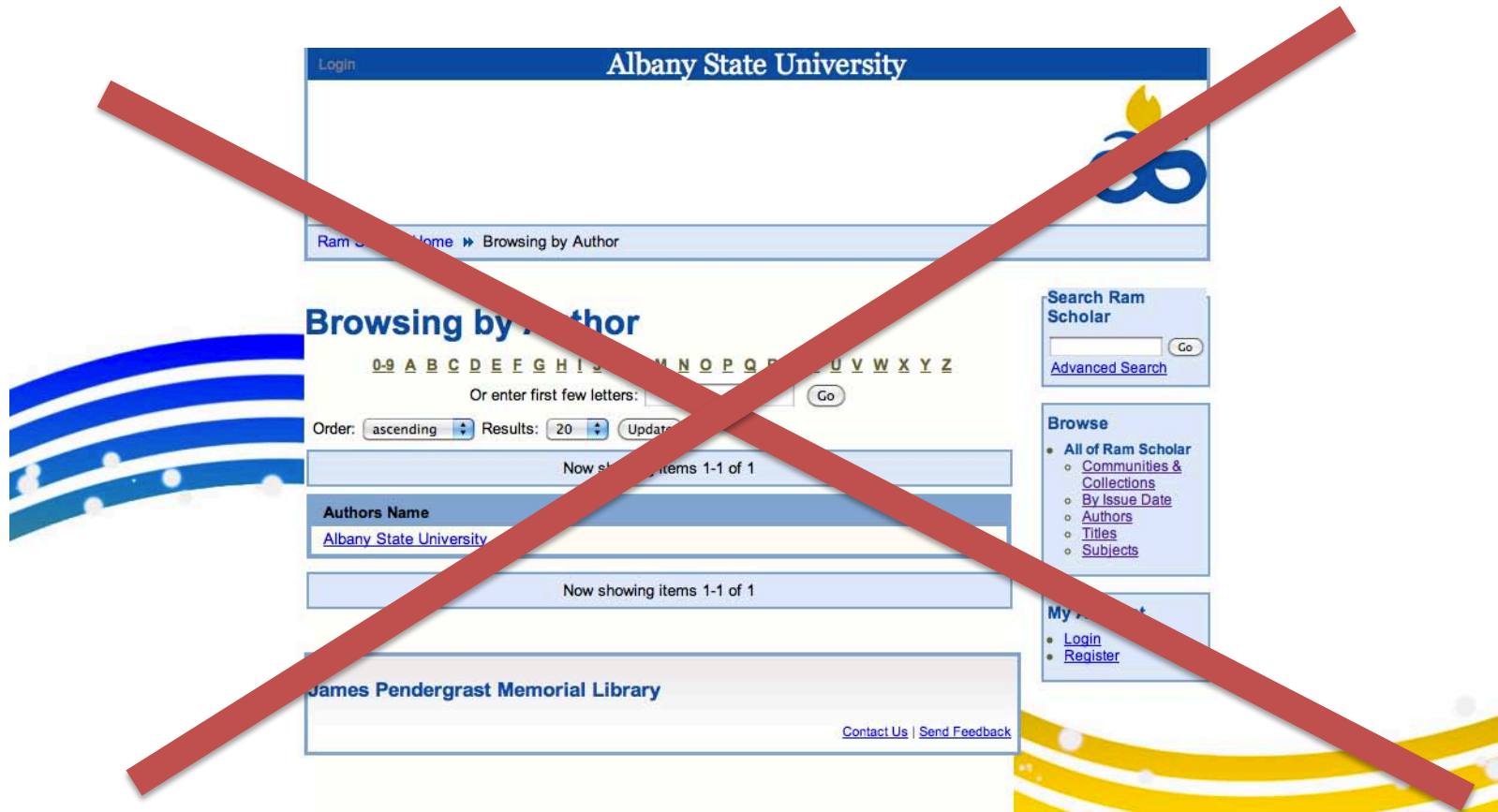
Bill: Keith did 90 percent of the work, but that last 10 percent always takes up 90 percent of the time and effort.




