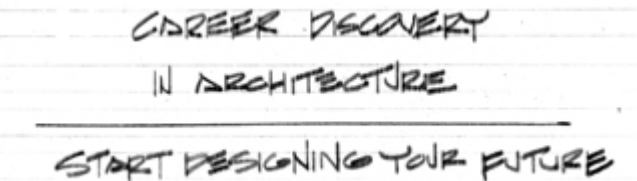
**Al-Haddad Wins Fulbright Exchange Position to Chile** Visiting assistant professor and local artist will teach digital manufacturing and design
